Amending Senate Resolution 400 (94th Congress) to make amendments arising from the enactment of the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 and to make other amendments.

2 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO SENATE RESOLUTION 400**

3 **(94TH CONGRESS) ARISING FROM ENACT-**

4 **MENT OF INTELLIGENCE REFORM AND TER-**

5 **RORISM PREVENTION ACT OF 2004.**

6 Senate Resolution 400, agreed to May 19, 1976

7 (94th Congress), is amended—

1 (1) in section 3—

2 (A) in subsection (a)—

3 (i) by redesignating paragraphs (2),
4 (3), and (4), as paragraphs (3), (4), and
5 (5), respectively;

6 (ii) by striking paragraph (1) and in-
7 serting the following new paragraphs:

8 “(1) The Office of the Director of National In-
9 telligence and the Director of National Intelligence.

10 “(2) The Central Intelligence Agency and the
11 Director of the Central Intelligence Agency.”; and

12 (iii) in paragraph (5), as so redesign-
13 nated—

14 (I) by redesignating subpara-
15 graphs (B) through (G) as subpara-
16 graphs (C) through (H), respectively;

17 (II) by striking subparagraph (A)
18 and inserting the following new sub-
19 paragraphs:

20 “(A) The Office of the Director of Na-
21 tional Intelligence and the Director of National
22 Intelligence.

23 “(B) The Central Intelligence Agency and
24 the Director of the Central Intelligence Agen-
25 cy.”; and

1 (III) in subparagraph (H), as so
2 redesignated—

3 (aa) by striking “clause (A),
4 (B), or (C)” and inserting
5 “clause (A), (B), (C), or (D)”;
6 and

7 (bb) by striking “clause (D),
8 (E), or (F)” both places it ap-
9 pears and inserting “clause (E),
10 (F), or (G)”;

11 (B) in subsection (b)(1), by striking
12 “clause (1) or (4)(A)” and inserting “clause
13 (1), (2), (5)(A), or (5)(B)”;

14 (2) in section 4(b), by inserting “the Director
15 of National Intelligence,” before “the Director of the
16 Central Intelligence Agency”;

17 (3) in section 6, by striking “the Director of
18 Central Intelligence” both places it appears and in-
19 serting “the Director of National Intelligence”; and

20 (4) in section 12—

21 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (2)
22 through (6) as paragraphs (3) through (7), re-
23 spectively; and

24 (B) by striking paragraph (1) and insert-
25 ing the following new paragraphs:

1 “(1) The activities of the Office of the Director
2 of National Intelligence and the Director of National
3 Intelligence.

4 “(2) The activities of the Central Intelligence
5 Agency and the Director of the Central Intelligence
6 Agency.”.

13 (94th Congress), is amended—

14 (1) in section 6, by striking “the Select Com-
15 mittee on Standards and Conduct” and inserting
16 “the Select Committee on Ethics”; and

17 (2) in section 8—

18 (A) in subsection (d), by striking “the Se-
19 lect Committee on Standards and Conduct” and
20 inserting “the Select Committee on Ethics”;
21 and

22 (B) in subsection (e), by striking “the Se-
23 lect Committee on Standards and Conduct”
24 both places it appears and inserting “the Select
25 Committee on Ethics”.

1 **SEC. 3. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO SENATE RESOLU-**
2 **TION 400 (94TH CONGRESS) RELATING TO RE-**
3 **MOVING REFERENCE TO THE INTELLIGENCE**
4 **DIVISION OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF IN-**
5 **VESTIGATION.**

6 Senate Resolution 400, agreed to May 19, 1976
7 (94th Congress), is amended by striking “, including all
8 activities of the Intelligence Division” in—

9 (1) paragraph (5)(F) of section 3(a), as redес-
10 igned by section 1(1)(A)(i); and

11 (2) paragraph (7) of section 12, as redesignated
12 by section 1(4)(A).

13 **SEC. 4. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO SENATE RESOLU-**
14 **TION 400 (94TH CONGRESS) RELATING TO**
15 **REFERENCES TO SENATE RULES.**

16 Senate Resolution 400, agreed to May 19, 1976
17 (94th Congress), is amended—

18 (1) in section 2(b), by striking “paragraph
19 6(f)” and inserting “paragraph 4(e)(1)”; and

20 (2) in section 8(b)(5)—

21 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
22 (A), by striking “section 133(f) of the Legisla-
23 tive Reorganization Act of 1946” and inserting
24 “paragraph 5 of rule XVII of the Standing
25 Rules of the Senate”; and

1 (B) in the flush text after subparagraph
2 (C), by striking “section 133(f) of the Legisla-
3 tive Reorganization Act of 1946” and inserting
4 “paragraph 5 of rule XVII of the Standing
5 Rules of the Senate”.

6 **SEC. 5. OTHER TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO SENATE RES-**
7 **OLUTION 400 (94TH CONGRESS).**

8 Section 3(b)(3) of Senate Resolution 400, agreed to
9 May 19, 1976 (94th Congress), is amended by striking
10 “the session” and inserting “in session”.

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
