CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on any legisla-
3 tive day from Friday, November 6, 2009, through Tues-
4 day, November 10, 2009, on a motion offered pursuant
5 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
6 designee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, No-
7 vember 16, 2009, or until the time of any reassembly

1 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
 2 ever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or
 3 adjourns on any day from Friday, November 6, 2009,
 4 through Tuesday, November 10, 2009, on a motion of-
 5 fered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Major-
 6 ity Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned
 7 until noon on Monday, November 16, 2009, or such other
 8 time on that day as may be specified in the motion to
 9 recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pur-
 10 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
 11 occurs first.

12 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
 13 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
 14 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
 15 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
 16 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
 17 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
 18 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant
 19 it.
