## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the Greater Washington Soap Box Derby.

1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate

2 concurring),

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Greater Washington Soap
4 Box Derby Association (in this resolution referred to as
5 the "sponsor") shall be permitted to sponsor a public
6 event, soap box derby races (in this resolution referred to
7 as the "event"), on the Capitol Grounds.

8 (b) DATE OF EVENT.—The event shall be held on 9 June 19, 2010, or on such other date as the Speaker of 10 the House of Representatives and the Committee on Rules 11 and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

### 12 SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed
by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
Board, the event shall be—

- 16 (1) free of admission charge and open to thepublic; and
- 18 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of19 Congress.

(b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsor shall
assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities
incident to all activities associated with the event.

### 23 SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.

Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Capitol, the sponsor is authorized to erect upon the Capitol
Grounds such stage, sound amplification devices, and

other related structures and equipment as may be required
 for the event.

### **3** SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.

4 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
5 Board are authorized to make such additional arrange6 ments as may be required to carry out the event.

### 7 SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.

8 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-9 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of 10 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-11 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds, 12 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol 13 Grounds, with respect to the event.
