- 2 referred to as the "event") may be run through the Cap-

- 4 torch to the District of Columbia Special Olympics sum-

- 6 SEC. 2. RESPONSIBILITY OF CAPITOL POLICE BOARD.
- 7 The Capitol Police Board shall take such actions as
- 8 may be necessary to carry out the event.
- 9 SEC. 3. CONDITIONS RELATING TO PHYSICAL PREPARA-
- 10 TIONS.
- 11 The Architect of the Capitol may prescribe conditions
- 12 for physical preparations for the event.
- 13 SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.
- 14 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
- 15 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of
- 16 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-
- 17 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds,
- 18 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol
- 19 Grounds, in connection with the event.
