AN ACT

- To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act with respect to the distribution of the drug dextromethorphan, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Dextromethorphan3 Distribution Act of 2009".

4 SEC. 2. RESTRICTIONS ON DISTRIBUTION OF BULK
5 DEXTROMETHORPHAN.

6 The Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21
7 U.S.C. 321 et seq.) is amended—

8 (1) in section 501, by inserting at the end the9 following:

"(j) If it is unfinished dextromethorphan and is possessed, received, or distributed in violation of section
506D."; and

13 (2) by inserting after section 506C the fol-14 lowing:

15 "SEC. 506D. RESTRICTIONS ON DISTRIBUTION OF BULK 16 DEXTROMETHORPHAN.

17 "(a) RESTRICTIONS.—No person shall—

18 **((1)** receive unfinished possess \mathbf{or} 19 dextromethorphan, unless the person is registered 20 under section 510 or otherwise registered, licensed, 21 or approved pursuant to Federal or State law to en-22 gage in the practice of pharmacy, pharmaceutical 23 production, or manufacture or distribution of drug 24 ingredients; or

25 "(2) distribute unfinished dextromethorphan to
26 any person other than a person registered under secHR 1259 RFS

tion 510 or otherwise registered, licensed, or approved pursuant to Federal or State law to engage
in the practice of pharmacy, pharmaceutical production, or manufacture or distribution of drug ingredients.

6 "(b) EXCEPTION FOR COMMON CARRIERS.—This 7 section does not apply to a common carrier that possesses, 8 receives, or distributes unfinished dextromethorphan for 9 purposes of distributing such unfinished 10 dextromethorphan between persons described in sub-11 section (a) as registered, licensed, or approved.

12 "(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

13 "(1) The term 'common carrier' means any per-14 son that holds itself out to the general public as a 15 provider for hire of the transportation by water, 16 land, or air of merchandise, whether or not the per-17 son actually operates the vessel, vehicle, or aircraft 18 by which the transportation is provided, between a 19 port or place and a port or place in the United 20 States.

"(2) The term 'unfinished dextromethorphan'
 means dextromethorphan that is not contained in a
 drug that is in finished dosage form.".
