AN ACT

To amend chapter 40 of title 18, United States Code, to exempt the transportation, shipment, receipt, or importation of explosive materials for delivery to a federally recognized Indian tribe or an agency of such a tribe from various Federal criminal prohibitions relating to explosives.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF THE TRANSPORTATION, SHIP-**
4 **MENT, RECEIPT, OR IMPORTATION OF EX-**
5 **PLOSIVE MATERIALS FOR DELIVERY TO A**
6 **FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED INDIAN TRIBE OR**
7 **AN AGENCY OF SUCH A TRIBE FROM VAR-**
8 **IOUS FEDERAL CRIMINAL PROHIBITIONS RE-**
9 **LATING TO EXPLOSIVES.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 845(a)(3) of title 18,
11 United States Code, is amended by striking “to any agen-
12 cy of the United States or to any State or any political
13 subdivision thereof” and inserting “to any agency of the
14 United States, to any State or any political subdivision
15 thereof, or to any federally recognized Indian tribe or
16 agency thereof”.

17 (b) INDIAN TRIBE DEFINED.—Section 841 of such
18 title is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(t) ‘Indian tribe’ has the meaning given the
2 term in section 102 of the Federally Recognized In-
3 dian Tribe List Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 479a).”.
