A BILL

To make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass available at a discount to certain veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VETERANS EAGLE PASSPORT.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
5 “Veterans Eagle Parks Pass Act”.

6 (b) VETERANS EAGLE PARKS PASS.—Section 805(b)
7 of division J of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2005
8 (16 U.S.C. 6804(b); 118 Stat. 3386), is amended by add-
9 ing at the end the following new paragraph:

1 “(3) VETERANS DISCOUNT.—The Secretary
2 shall make the National Parks and Federal Rec-
3 reational Lands Pass available, at a cost of \$10, to
4 any veteran who was separated from military service
5 under conditions other than dishonorable, if the vet-
6 eran provides proof of that status by presenting a
7 DD214. The National Parks and Federal Rec-
8 reational Lands Pass made available under this
9 paragraph shall be valid for 1 year from the date of
10 issuance.”.
