- 4 York, shall be known and designated as the "Caroline
- 5 O'Day Post Office Building".
- 6 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 7 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 8 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 9 be deemed to be a reference to the "Caroline O'Day Post
- 10 Office Building".
