## A BILL

To take certain property in McIntosh County, Oklahoma, into trust for the benefit of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fountainhead Prop-
- 5 erty Land Transfer Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF LAND; LAND INTO TRUST.
- 7 (a) In General.—Immediately after completion of
- 8 the survey required under subsection (b), the receipt of
- 9 consideration and costs required under subsection (c), and
- 10 satisfaction of all terms specified by the Secretary of the

- 1 Interior under subsection (d), administrative jurisdiction
- 2 of the Property shall be transferred to the Secretary and
- 3 the Secretary shall take the Property into trust for the
- 4 benefit of the Tribe.
- 5 (b) Survey.—The exact acreage and legal descrip-
- 6 tion of the Property shall be determined by a survey satis-
- 7 factory to the Secretary.
- 8 (c) Consideration; Costs.—The Tribe shall pay to
- 9 the Secretary—
- 10 (1) fair market value of the Property, as deter-
- 11 mined by the Secretary;
- 12 (2) the cost of the survey required by sub-
- section (b); and
- 14 (3) all costs and administrative expenses associ-
- ated with the transfer of administrative jurisdiction
- of the Property and taking the Property into trust
- pursuant to subsection (a), including costs of any
- 18 environmental remediation.
- 19 (d) Other Terms and Conditions.—The transfer
- 20 of administrative jurisdiction of the Property and taking
- 21 the Property into trust shall be subject to such other
- 22 terms and conditions as the Secretary considers appro-
- 23 priate to protect the interests of the United States, includ-
- 24 ing reservation of flowage easements consistent with the
- 25 Acquisition Guide Line for Flowage Easement for the

- 1 Lake Eufaula project and other applicable policies for that
- 2 project.
- 3 (e) Definitions.—For the purposes of this section:
- 4 (1) Property.—The term "Property" means,
- 5 subject to valid existing rights, all right, title, and
- 6 interest (including improvements and appur-
- 7 tenances) of the United States in and to the Federal
- 8 land generally described as the approximately 18
- 9 acres of Federal land located in McIntosh County,
- 10 Oklahoma, within the boundary of the Muscogee
- 11 (Creek) Nation and located in Northwest Quarter of
- 12 Section 3, Township 10 North, Range 16 East,
- McIntosh County, Oklahoma, at Lake Eufaula.
- 14 (2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- 15 the Secretary of the Interior.
- 16 (3) Tribe.—The term "Tribe" means the
- 17 Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
- 18 (f) Gaming pursuant to the Indian Gam-
- $19\,$ ing Regulatory Act (25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) may not be
- 20 conducted on the Property, except as provided under sec-
- 21 tion 20(b)(1)(A) of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (25
- 22 U.S.C. 2719(b)(1)(A)).
