A BILL

To take certain property in McIntosh County, Oklahoma, into trust for the benefit of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Fountainhead Property
5	Land Transfer Act".
6	SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF LAND; LAND INTO TRUST.
7	(a) In General.—Immediately after completion of the
8	survey required under subsection (b), the receipt of consider-
9	ation and costs required under subsection (c), and satisfac-
10	tion of all terms specified by the Secretary and the Sec-
11	retary of the Army under subsection (d), administrative ju-
12	risdiction of the Property shall be transferred from the Sec-
13	retary of the Army to the Secretary and the Secretary shall
14	take the Property into trust for the benefit of the Tribe.
15	(b) Survey.—The exact acreage and legal description
16	of the Property shall be determined by a survey satisfactory
17	to the Secretary and the Secretary of the Army.
18	(c) Consideration; Costs.—The Tribe shall pay—
19	(1) to the Secretary of the Army fair market
20	value of the Property, as determined by the Secretary
21	of the Army; and
22	(2) all costs and administrative expenses associ-
23	ated with the transfer of administrative jurisdiction
24	of the Property and taking the Property into trust
25	pursuant to subsection (a), including costs of the sur-

- vey provided for in subsection (b) and any environ-1 2 mental remediation. 3 (d) Other Terms and Conditions.—The transfer of administrative jurisdiction of the Property and taking the Property into trust shall be subject to such other terms and conditions as the Secretary and the Secretary of the Army consider appropriate to protect the interests of the United 8 States, including reservation of flowage easements consistent with the Acquisition Guide Line for Flowage Easement for the Lake Eufaula project and other applicable 10 11 policies for that project. 12 (e) Definitions.—For the purposes of this section: 13 (1) Property.—The term "Property" means, 14 subject to valid existing rights, all right, title, and in-15 terest of the United States in and to the Federal land 16 generally described as the approximately 18 acres of 17 Federal land located in McIntosh County, Oklahoma, 18 within the boundary of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation 19 and located in Northwest Quarter of Section 3, Town-20 ship 10 North, Range 16 East, McIntosh County, Oklahoma, at Lake Eufaula. 21 22
 - (2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Interior.
- 24 (3) TRIBE.—The term "Tribe" means the
 25 Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
