A BILL

To amend the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act to designate a segment of Illabot Creek in Skagit County, Washington, as a component of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF WILD AND SCENIC RIVER
4	SEGMENTS.
5	Section 3(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16
6	U.S.C. 1274(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7	lowing:
8	"() Illabot creek, washington.—
9	"(A) The 14.3 mile segment from the head-
10	waters of Illabot Creek to the north 1/16 line of
11	section 34, township 35 north, range 10 east,
12	Willamette Meridian, excepting any lands north
13	of a line 200 feet southerly and perpendicular to
14	the southerly right-of-way line of the Rockport-
15	Cascade Road, through lands of the United
16	States, the Washington State Department of Nat-
17	ural Resources, and lands owned by, or adminis-
18	tered by agencies of, the City of Seattle, except-
19	ing any lands under any private ownership to be
20	administered by the Secretary of Agriculture as
21	follows:
22	"(i) The 4.3 mile segment from the
23	headwaters of Illabot Creek to the boundary
24	of Glacier Peak Wilderness Area as a wild
25	river.

1	"(ii) The 10 mile segment from the
2	boundary of Glacier Peak Wilderness to
3	north 1/16 line of section 34, township 35
4	north, range 10 east, Willamette Meridian,
5	excepting any lands north of a line 200 feet
6	southerly and perpendicular to the southerly
7	right-of-way line of the Rockport-Cascade
8	Road as a recreational river.
9	"(B) Action required to be taken under sub-
10	section (d)(1) for the river segments designated
11	under this paragraph shall be completed through
12	revision of the Skagit Wild and Scenic River
13	comprehensive management plan.".
