AN ACT

To provide for a program of research, development, and demonstration on natural gas vehicles.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1SECTION1.NATURALGASVEHICLERESEARCH,2DEVELOPMENT,ANDDEMONSTRATION3PROJECTS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Energy shall
5 conduct a 5-year program of natural gas vehicle research,
6 development, and demonstration. The Secretary shall
7 coordinate with the Administrator of the Environmental
8 Protection Agency, as necessary.

9 (b) PURPOSE.—The program under this section shall10 focus on—

(1) the continued improvement and development of new, cleaner, more efficient light-duty, medium-duty, and heavy-duty natural gas vehicle engines;

(2) the integration of those engines into lightduty, medium-duty, and heavy-duty natural gas
vehicles for onroad and offroad applications;

(3) expanding product availability by ensuring
that technologies researched and developed assist
engines and vehicles in meeting Federal and State
requirements and standards;

(4) the demonstration and proper operation and
use of the vehicles described in paragraph (2) under
all operating conditions;

(5) the development and improvement of
 nationally recognized codes and standards for the
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1	continued safe operation of natural gas vehicles and
2	their components;
3	(6) improvement in the reliability and efficiency
4	of natural gas fueling station infrastructure;
5	(7) the certification of natural gas fueling
6	station infrastructure to nationally recognized and
7	industry safety standards;
8	(8) the improvement in the reliability and
9	efficiency of onboard natural gas fuel storage sys-
10	tems;
11	(9) the development of new natural gas fuel
12	storage materials;
13	(10) the certification of onboard natural gas
14	fuel storage systems to nationally recognized and in-
15	dustry safety standards;
16	(11) the use of natural gas engines in hybrid
17	vehicles; and
18	(12) researching and developing technologies
19	and processes so as to improve and streamline the
20	process by which natural gas conversion systems
21	meet Federal and State requirements and standards.
22	(c) Cooperation and Coordination With
23	INDUSTRY.—In developing and carrying out the program
24	under this section, the Secretary shall coordinate with the

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natural gas vehicle industry to ensure cooperation between
 the public and the private sector.

3 (d) CONDUCT OF PROGRAM.—The program under
4 this section shall be conducted in accordance with sections
5 3001 and 3002 of the Energy Policy Act of 1992.

6 (e) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date 7 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall provide a re-8 port to Congress on the implementation of this section. 9 (f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There 10 are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary 11 \$30,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2010 through 12 2014 to carry out this section.

(g) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this section, the
term "natural gas" means compressed natural gas, liquefied natural gas, biomethane, and mixtures of hydrogen
and methane or natural gas.
