A BILL

To amend the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act to require notifications under that Act for mass layoffs that occur at more than one site of an employer and to increase penalties for violation of the Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Alert Laid off Employ-
5 ees in Reasonable Time Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MASS LAYOFFS OF A SINGLE EMPLOYER AT MUL-**
2 **TIPLE SITES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2(a)(3) of the Worker Ad-
4 justment and Retraining Notification Act (29 U.S.C.
5 2101(a)(3)) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (B)(ii) by inserting “or”
7 after the semicolon; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(C) results in an employment loss for a
10 single employer at more than 1 site of employ-
11 ment during any 30-day period for—

12 “(i)(I) at least 33 percent of the em-
13 ployees of the employer (excluding any
14 part-time employees); and

15 “(II) at least 50 employees (excluding
16 any part-time employees); or

17 “(ii) at least 500 employees (excluding
18 any part-time employees);”.

19 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 3(a)(2) of
20 such Act (29 U.S.C. 2102(a)(2)) is amended by striking
21 “to the State” and inserting “in the case of a plant closing
22 or mass layoff described in section 2(a)(3)(B), to the
23 State”.

24 **SEC. 3. INCREASED PENALTIES.**

25 Section 5(a)(1)(A) of the Worker Adjustment and
26 Retraining Notification Act (29 U.S.C. 2104(a)(1)(A)) is

- 1 amended by striking “back pay” and inserting “two times
- 2 the amount of back pay”.
