3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS TO TRANSFER**
4 **ENEMY COMBATANTS DETAINED AT NAVAL**
5 **STATION, GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA, TO FA-**
6 **CILITIES IN OHIO.**

7 None of the funds appropriated or otherwise made
8 available to any Federal department or agency may be

1 used to transfer any enemy combatant detained by the
2 United States at Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba,
3 to any facility in Ohio or to construct any facility in Ohio
4 for any enemy combatant.

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
