## **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Common Sense in Sen-5 tencing Act of 2009".

6 SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE A SENTENCE BELOW A
7 STATUTORY MINIMUM.

8 Section 3553 of title 18, United States Code, is9 amended by adding at the end the following:

"(g) AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE A SENTENCE BELOW A
 STATUTORY MINIMUM TO PREVENT AN UNJUST SEN TENCE.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
 court may impose a sentence below a statutory minimum
 if the court finds that it is necessary to do so in order
 to avoid violating the requirements of subsection (a).".
