3 SECTION 1. NEW JUDGESHIPS FOR EASTERN DISTRICT OF

4 CALIFORNIA.

5 (a) PERMANENT JUDGESHIPS.—The President shall6 appoint, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,

4 additional district judges for the eastern district of Cali 2 fornia.

3 (b) TEMPORARY JUDGESHIP.—

4 (1) APPOINTMENT.—The President shall appoint, by and with the advice and consent of the
6 Senate, 1 additional district judge for the eastern
7 district of California.

8 (2) FIRST VACANCY NOT FILLED.—The first va-9 cancy in the office of district judge in the eastern 10 district of California occurring 10 years or more 11 after the confirmation date of the judge named to 12 fill the judgeship created by paragraph (1) shall not 13 be filled.

14 (c) TABLE.—In order that the table contained in sec-15 tion 133(a) of title 28, United States Code, reflects the 16 total number of permanent district judgeships authorized 17 by virtue of subsection (a) of this section, such table is 18 amended by striking the item relating to California and 19 inserting the following:

Central
Southern

20 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
21 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
22 necessary to carry out this section, including such sums

as may be necessary to provide appropriate space and fa cilities for the judicial positions created by this section.

3 SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL PLACE OF HOLDING COURT.

4 Section 84(b) of title 28, United States Code, is
5 amended in the second sentence by inserting "Bakers6 field," after "shall be held at".
