- 3 SECTION 1. INCREASE IN MAXIMUM AGE TO QUALIFY FOR
- 4 COVERAGE AS A "CHILD".
- 5 (a) In General.—Section 8901(5) of title 5, United
- 6 States Code, is amended—

1	(1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
2	by striking "22 years of age" and inserting "25
3	years of age"; and
4	(2) in the matter following subparagraph (B),
5	by striking "age 22" and inserting "age 25".
6	(b) Self and Family Coverage for a Former
7	SPOUSE.—Section 8905(c)(2)(B) of title 5, United States
8	Code, is amended—
9	(1) in clause (i), by striking "22 years of age"
10	and inserting "25 years of age"; and
11	(2) in clause (ii), by striking "age 22" and in-
12	serting "age 25".
13	(c) Effective Date.—This Act and the amend-
14	ments made by this Act—
15	(1) shall take effect on the first day of the first
16	contract year beginning at least 180 days after the
17	date of the enactment of this Act; and
18	(2) shall apply with respect to health care serv-
19	ices or supplies provided on or after the date on
20	which this Act takes effect.
