7 (a) EXPANSION.—Section 1318(b) of title 38, United 8 States Code, is amended by striking "if—" and all that 9 follows through the period at the end and inserting the 10 following: "if the disability was continuously rated totally 11 disabling for a period of not less than one year imme-12 diately preceding death.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall apply with respect to deaths occurring
on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
