A BILL

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Energy Employees Oc-
3	cupational Illness Compensation Program Improvement
4	Act of 2009".
5	SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION TO SURVIVORS OF
6	DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY CONTRACTOR EM-
7	PLOYEES.
8	(a) In General.—Section 3672 of the Energy Em-
9	ployees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act
10	of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 7385s-1) is amended to read as fol-
11	lows:
12	"SEC. 3672. COMPENSATION TO BE PROVIDED.
13	"Subject to the other provisions of this subtitle:
14	"(1) Contractor employees.—
15	"(A) IN GENERAL.—A covered DOE con-
16	tractor employee shall receive contractor em-
17	ployee compensation under this subtitle in ac-
18	cordance with section 3673.
19	"(B) Compensation after death of
20	CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE.—
21	"(i) In general.—Except as pro-
22	vided in paragraph (2)(B), if the death of
23	a contractor employee occurs after the em-
24	ployee applies for compensation under this
25	subtitle but before such compensation is
26	paid, the amount of compensation de-

scribed in clause (ii) shall be paid to a survivor (as that term is used in section 3674) of the employee or, if the employee has no such survivors, to the surviving family members of the employee in accordance with the procedures set forth in section 3628(e)(1).

"(ii) Amount of compensation.—
The amount of compensation described in this clause is the amount of compensation the contractor employee would have received pursuant to section 3673(a), except that if the Secretary cannot determine the minimum impairment rating of the employee under paragraph (1) of such section as a result of the death of the employee, such compensation shall not include compensation pursuant to such paragraph.

"(2) Survivors.—

"(A) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subparagraph (B) or paragraph (1)(B), a survivor of a covered DOE contractor employee shall receive contractor employee compensation under this subtitle in accordance with section 3674.

"(B) ELECTION OF CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION OR SURVIVOR COMPENSATION.—A survivor who is otherwise eligible to receive compensation pursuant to both subparagraph (A) and paragraph (1)(B) shall not receive compensation pursuant to both subparagraph (A) and paragraph (1)(B), but shall receive compensation pursuant to subparagraph (A) or paragraph (1)(B), as elected by the survivor.

"(C) Compensation after death of a survivor occurs after the survivor applies for compensation under this subtitle but before such compensation is paid and, in the case of compensation pursuant to paragraph (1)(B), there are no other survivors (as that term is used in section 3674) of the employee, the amount of compensation the survivor would have received under this section shall be paid to the surviving family members of the employee in accordance with the procedures set forth in section 3628(e)(1)."

24 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The provisions of section 3672
