## A BILL

To repeal certain provisions of title 5, United States Code, relating to Federal employees' official time and labor organization activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Employee Ac-  
5 countability Act of 2009".

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS RELATING TO OF-**  
2 **FICIAL TIME.**

3 Subsections (a) and (c) of section 7131 of title 5,  
4 United States Code, are repealed.
