3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Food Assistance to
5 Improve Reintegration Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF DENIAL OF BENEFITS.**

7 Section 115 of the Personal Responsibility and Work
8 Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (21 U.S.C. 862a)
9 is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a) by striking paragraph (2);

2 (2) in subsection (b) by striking paragraph (2);

3 and

4 (3) in subsection (e) by striking paragraph (2).
