- 3 SECTION 1. SOUTH ATLANTIC RED SNAPPER FISHERY.
- 4 (a) POPULATION STUDY.—The Secretary of Com-
- 5 merce shall conduct a study of the population of the South

- 1 Atlantic red snapper fishery and submit to Congress a re-
- 2 port on the findings of such study.
- 3 (b) Limitation on Interim Rule Closing Fish-
- 4 ERY.—
- 5 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Commerce 6 may not promulgate any interim rule under section
- 7 305(c) of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conserva-
- 8 tion and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1855(c)) that
- 9 prohibits fishing in the South Atlantic red snapper
- 10 fishery before the date the Secretary submits to
- 11 Congress a report on findings of a study under sub-
- section (b) that demonstrate the need for such in-
- terim rules.
- 14 (2) Existing interim rules.—Any interim
- rule described in paragraph (1) that was promul-
- 16 gated before the date of enactment of this Act shall
- have no force or effect.
