1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3	SECTION 1. 11-AMINOUNDECANOIC ACID.
4	(a) In General.—Heading 9902.32.49 of the Har-
5	monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6	11-Aminoundecanoic acid) is amended—
7	(1) in the general rate of duty column, by strik-
8	ing "2.3%" and inserting "Free"; and
9	(2) by striking the date in the effective period
10	column and inserting "12/31/2012".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
- 3 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of

5 this Act.
