1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Digital Television Cou-

5 pon Improvement Act".

6 SEC. 2. COUPON EXPIRATION EXTENSION.

7 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 3005(c)(1)(C) of the Dig-

8 ital Television Transition and Public Safety Act of 2005

9 (Public Law 109–171; 120 Stat. 23) is amended to read

10 as follows:

"(C) NO EXPIRATION.—All coupons issued
 under this section shall expire at the close of
 March 31, 2009.".

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall apply to any coupon issued under sec6 tion 3005 of the Digital Television Transition and Public
7 Safety Act of 2005 on or after the date of enactment of
8 such Act.
