A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF MEDICARE DME ACCREDITA-**
4 **TION DEADLINE FOR CERTAIN PHARMACIES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1834(a)(20)(F)(i) of the
6 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m(a)(20)(F)(i)) is

1 amended by inserting before the semicolon the following:
2 “, except that the Secretary shall not require under this
3 clause pharmacies to obtain such accreditation before Jan-
4 uary 1, 2010”.

5 (b) CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in subsection (a) shall
6 be construed as affecting the application of an accredita-
7 tion requirement for pharmacies to qualify for bidding in
8 a competitive acquisition area under section 1847 of the
9 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–3).
