1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN SYNTHETIC FILAMENT YARNS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.01.90 of the Har5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 certain synthetic filament yarns) is amended by striking
7 "12/31/2009" and inserting "12/31/2011".

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
