6	(1) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking "and"
7	after the semicolon;
8	(2) by striking the period at the end of para-
9	graph $(1)(C)$ and all that follows through paragraph
10	(2) and inserting "; and;
11	(3) in paragraph (1), by adding at the following
12	new subparagraph:
13	"(D) appropriate agreements have been ex-
14	ecuted to ensure that project beneficiaries will
15	be solely responsible for repaying the entire
16	capital and operational costs of the project.";
17	(4) by striking so much as precedes the first
18	sentence and inserting "(a) IN GENERAL.—";
19	(5) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) through
20	(D) (as added by paragraph (3) of this section) as
21	paragraphs (1) through (4); and
22	(6) by moving paragraphs (1) through (4) (as
