A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend the employer wage credit for employees who are active duty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business and
5 Military Family Assistance Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF EMPLOYER WAGE CREDIT FOR EM-**
2 **PLOYEES WHO ARE ACTIVE DUTY MEMBERS**
3 **OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (f) of section 45P of
5 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to employer
6 wage credit for employees who are active duty members
7 of the Uniformed Services) is amended by striking “De-
8 cember 31, 2009” and inserting “December 31, 2011”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) shall apply to payments made after Decem-
11 ber 31, 2009.

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
