## A BILL

To require insurers of motor vehicles to provide coverage of bodily injuries in insurance policies.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REQUIRED COVERAGE OF BODILY INJURIES IN
- 4 MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICES.
- 5 (a) In General.—An insurer of a motor vehicle
- 6 shall provide in each motor vehicle insurance policy such
- 7 insurer issues liability coverage for bodily injuries and
- 8 death as described in subsection (b).
- 9 (b) MINIMUM COVERAGE.—A policy referred to in
- 10 subsection (a) shall include, for injuries to or death of per-

- 1 sons arising from an incident involving a motor vehicle or
- 2 driver covered by such policy—
- 3 (1) not less than \$25,000 in liability coverage
- 4 for injuries to or death of an individual; and
- 5 (2) not less than \$50,000 in total liability cov-
- 6 erage for all injuries to or deaths of persons arising
- 7 from such incident.
- 8 (c) Motor Vehicle Defined.—The term "motor
- 9 vehicle" has the meaning given the term in section
- 10 30102(a)(6) of title 49, United States Code.

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
