1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON PROSECUTION OF**
4 **UNPRIVILEGED ENEMY COMBATANTS BY DE-**
5 **PARTMENT OF JUSTICE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Department of Justice shall
7 not prosecute any unprivileged enemy combatant for any
8 offense.

9 (b) UNPRIVILEGED ENEMY COMBATANT DEFINED.—
10 The term “unprivileged enemy combatant” has the mean-

1 ing given that term in section 948a(7) of title 10, United
2 States Code.
