3 **SECTION 1. HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE FACILITY USE.**

4 Section 166(b)(3) of title 23, United States Code, is
5 amended—

1 (1) in the heading by striking “PUBLIC TRANS-
2 PORTATION” and inserting “CERTAIN AUTHORIZED”;
3 and

4 (2) by inserting after “may allow public trans-
5 portation vehicles” the following: “, vehicles operated
6 by members of the Armed Forces (including reserve
7 components thereof) serving on active duty, and ve-
8 hicles operated by law enforcement officials”.
