## A BILL

To prohibit the further extension or establishment of national  
monuments in Colorado, except by express authorization  
of Congress.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ES-**  
4                               **TABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**  
5                               **COLORADO.**

6       This proviso of the last sentence of the first section  
7       of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter  
8       950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting “or Colo-  
9       rado” after “Wyoming”.
