A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend the nonbusiness energy property credit to include insulated siding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NONBUSINESS ENERGY PROPERTY TO IN-**
4 **CLUDE INSULATED SIDING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (2) of section 25C(c)
6 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by strik-
7 ing “and” at the end of subparagraph (C), by striking the
8 period at the end of subparagraph (D) and inserting “,
9 and”, and by adding at the end the following new subpara-
10 graph:

1 “(E) any building cladding system (includ-
2 ing vinyl siding) with integral insulating mate-
3 rial that has a minimum thermal resistance of
4 R-2.”.

5 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
6 this section shall apply to property placed in service after
7 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
