2 **LANCE CORPORAL MICHAEL A. SCHWARZ**
3 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 331 1st Street in Carlstadt, New
6 Jersey, shall be known and designated as the “Staff Ser-
7 geant Frank T. Carvill and Lance Corporal Michael A.
8 Schwarz Post Office Building”.

9 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
10 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
11 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
12 be deemed to be a reference to the “Staff Sergeant Frank
13 T. Carvill and Lance Corporal Michael A. Schwarz Post
14 Office Building”.
