A BILL

To match the boundaries of Lewis and Clark National Historic Park and Cape Disappointment and Fort Columbia State Parks in the State of Washington, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Lewis and Clark Na-
- 5 tional and State Historical Parks Partnership Act of
- 6 2010".

1 SEC. 2. ADMINISTRATIVE BOUNDARY CORRECTIONS.

2	Section 103(b) of the Lewis and Clark National His-
3	torical Park Designation Act (16 U.S.C. 410kkk note;
4	Public Law 108–387) is amended to read as follows:
5	"(b) Boundaries.—The boundaries of the park are
6	those generally depicted on the map titled
7	', numbered, and
8	dated and includes the following:
9	"(1) Lands located in Clatsop County, Oregon,
10	that are associated with the winter encampment of
11	the Lewis and Clark Expedition, known as Fort
12	Clatsop and designated as the Fort Clatsop National
13	Memorial by Public Law 85–435, including the site
14	of the salt cairn (specifically, lot number 18, block
15	1, Cartwright Park Addition of Seaside, Oregon)
16	used by that expedition and adjacent portions of the
17	old trail which led overland from the fort to the
18	coast.
19	"(2) Lands identified as 'Fort Clatsop 2002
20	Addition Lands' on the map referred to in this sub-
21	section.
22	"(3) Lands located along the lower Columbia
23	River in the State of Washington associated with the
24	arrival of the Lewis and Clark Expedition at the Pa-
25	cific Ocean in 1805, which are identified as 'Station
26	Camp', 'Clark's Dismal Nitch', 'Cape Disappoint-

- 1 ment', and 'Fort Columbia' on the map referred to
- 2 in this subsection.".
