- 2 the "Sergeant Robert Barrett Post Office Building".
- 3 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 6 be deemed to be a reference to the "Sergeant Robert Bar-
- 7 rett Post Office Building".
