To require the Federal Government to pay the costs incurred by a State or local government in defending a State or local immigration law that survives a constitutional challenge by the Federal Government in Federal court.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Respect for Local
- 5 Laws Act".

1	SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COURT COSTS
2	RELATED TO FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CHAL-
3	LENGE OF STATE IMMIGRATION LAW.
4	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all attor-
5	neys' fees and associated court costs incurred by a State
6	or unit of local government in the course of defending a
7	constitutional challenge to a State law or a municipal ordi-
8	nance regarding immigration that is brought by the Fed-
9	eral Government in any Federal court shall be paid by the
10	Federal Government if the court upholds, in whole or in
11	part, the challenged State law or municipal ordinance.
