# A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that payments under the Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance program shall be made in a lump sum, unless the insured or the beneficiary elects otherwise.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Life Insurance
- 5 Transparency Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF CLAIMS.

- 2 (a) In General.—Section 8705 of title 5, United
- 3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 4 lowing:
- 5 ``(f)(1) The employee may elect settlement of insur-
- 6 ance under this chapter either in a lump sum or by such
- 7 alternative form of payment as the Office may (in addition
- 8 to a lump-sum payment) provide for.
- 9 "(2)(A) If the employee does not make such an elec-
- 10 tion, the beneficiary or beneficiaries may elect settlement
- 11 by any form of payment that was available to the employee
- 12 under paragraph (1).
- 13 "(B) If the employee does make such an election, the
- 14 beneficiary or beneficiaries may elect settlement by any
- 15 other form of payment that was available to the employee
- 16 under paragraph (1).
- 17 "(3) An election under paragraph (1) or (2) shall not
- 18 be effective unless it is submitted to the Office, in writing,
- 19 in such form and manner as the Office prescribes.
- 20 "(4) If no election is made under this subsection, the
- 21 settlement shall be made in the form of a lump-sum pay-
- 22 ment.".
- (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 24 subsection (a) shall apply in the case of any employee who
- 25 first becomes insured under chapter 87 of title 5, United
- 26 States Code, in any calendar year beginning at least 3

- 1 months after the date of the enactment of this Act. For
- 2 purposes of the preceding sentence, the term "employee"
- 3 has the meaning given such term under section 8701 of

4 such title.

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
