## A BILL

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to authorize the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to make additional capitalization grants to the water pollution control revolving funds of States that adopt smart growth principles.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SMART GROWTH ALLOTMENTS.**

4       Section 604 of the Federal Water Pollution Control  
5       Act (33 U.S.C. 1384) is amended by adding at the end  
6       the following:

7       “(d) SMART GROWTH ALLOTMENTS.—

1           “(1) IN GENERAL.—In addition to making cap-  
2           italization grants under section 601(a) for a fiscal  
3           year, the Administrator shall make available funds  
4           for distribution among eligible States under a for-  
5           mula to be determined by the Administrator.

6           “(2) USE OF FUNDS.—Funds distributed to a  
7           State under paragraph (1) shall be available to the  
8           State for the purposes described in section 601(a)  
9           and shall be subject to the same terms and condi-  
10          tions as apply to capitalization grants made under  
11          that section.

12          “(3) ELIGIBLE STATES.—In this subsection, the  
13          term ‘eligible State’ means a State that has adopted  
14          smart growth principles, as determined by the Ad-  
15          ministrator.

16          “(4) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—  
17          There is authorized to be appropriated for fiscal  
18          year 2011, and each fiscal year thereafter, to carry  
19          out this subsection a sum equal to 5 percent of the  
20          amount made available for capitalization grants  
21          under section 601(a) for the fiscal year.”.
