Mr. TAYLOR (for himself, Mr. SKELTON, Mr. JONES, and Mr. BARTLETT) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to seek to enter into certain contracts regarding roller systems.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SELF-PROTECTIVE ADAPTIVE ROLLER KIT II**
4 **SYSTEM.**

5 (a) PURCHASE OR LEASE OF TECHNICAL DATA
6 PACKAGE.—Not later than 10 days after the date of the
7 enactment of this Act, and in accordance with subsection
8 (b)(2), the Secretary of the Army shall seek to enter into
9 a contract with Pearson Engineering Limited of New-
10 castle, the United Kingdom, for the purchase or unlimited

1 lease of the self-protective adaptive roller kit II system
2 technical data package.

3 (b) PROCUREMENT OF SYSTEM.—

4 (1) PRODUCTION.—Not later than three days
5 after the date on which the Secretary enters into a
6 contract under subsection (a), the Secretary shall
7 seek to enter into contracts to procure the self-pro-
8 tective adaptive roller kit II system with any domes-
9 tic manufacturer with capacity to produce such sys-
10 tem.

11 (2) TERMINATION OF PEARSON CONTRACTS.—

12 If no contract is entered into under paragraph (1)
13 by the date that is 30 days after the date on which
14 the Secretary enters into a contract under sub-
15 section (a), the Secretary shall terminate—

16 (A) the contract entered into under sub-
17 section (a); and

18 (B) any contract entered into by the Sec-
19 retary with Pearson Engineering Limited with
20 respect to the self-protective adaptive roller kit
21 II system.

22 (c) PANAMA CITY GENERATION THREE.—

23 (1) FAILURE TO ENTER INTO TECHNICAL DATA
24 PACKAGE CONTRACT.—If no contract is entered into
25 under subsection (a) by the date that is 30 days

1 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
2 retary, in coordination with the Secretary of the
3 Navy, shall seek to enter into contracts to procure
4 the Panama City generation three roller system.

5 (2) FAILURE TO ENTER INTO PRODUCTION
6 CONTRACT.—If no contract is entered into under
7 subsection (b)(1) by the date that is 30 days after
8 the date on which the Secretary enters into a con-
9 tract under subsection (a), the Secretary, in coordi-
10 nation with the Secretary of the Navy, shall seek to
11 enter into contracts to procure the Panama City
12 generation three roller system.

13 (d) RAPID ACQUISITION AUTHORITY.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise pro-
15 vided in this section, the Secretary shall carry out
16 this section in accordance with section 807 of the
17 Bob Stump National Defense Authorization Act for
18 Fiscal Year 2003 (Public Law 107–314; 10 U.S.C.
19 2302 note).

20 (2) DETERMINATION.—For purposes of section
21 807(c)(1) of such Act, the self-protective adaptive
22 roller kit II system technical data package, the self-
23 protective adaptive roller kit II system, and the Pan-
24 ama City generation three roller system are deemed
25 to have been determined in writing by the Secretary

1 of Defense as being urgently needed to eliminate a
2 combat capability deficiency that has resulted in
3 combat fatalities.

4 (3) FUNDING.—For purposes of section
5 807(c)(3) of such Act—

6 (A) funds used to enter into a contract
7 under this section shall not apply to the
8 \$100,000,000 aggregate amount; and

9 (B) the Secretary may use any funds avail-
10 able to the Department of Defense for any fis-
11 cal year to enter into a contract under this sec-
12 tion.

13 (4) QUANTITY.—Section 807(f) of such Act
14 shall not apply to self-protective adaptive roller kit
15 II systems or Panama City generation three roller
16 systems procured under this section.

17 (e) WAIVER.—The Secretary of Defense may waive
18 the requirements under this Act to seek to enter into con-
19 tracts if the Secretary—

20 (1) determines that entering into such contracts
21 will result in unnecessary combat casualties; and

22 (2) submits to the congressional defense com-
23 mittees a written notification of such determination,
24 including the reasons supporting such determination.

25 (f) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1 (1) The term “congressional defense commit-
2 tees” has the meaning given that term in section
3 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States Code.

4 (2) The term “self-protective adaptive roller kit
5 II system technical data package” means the tech-
6 nical drawings, specifications, and other engineering
7 data necessary for the production of the self-protective
8 adaptive roller kit II system.
