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## A BILL

To amend part A of title XI of the Social Security Act to provide for a 1-year extension of the authorizations for the Work Incentives Planning and Assistance program and the Protection and Advocacy for Beneficiaries of Social Security program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “WIPA and PABSS  
5 Extension Act of 2010”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATIONS FOR THE WORK**  
2 **INCENTIVES PLANNING AND ASSISTANCE**  
3 **PROGRAM AND THE PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY FOR BENEFICIARIES OF SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAM.**

6 (a) WORK INCENTIVES PLANNING AND ASSISTANCE.—Section 1149(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b–20(d)) is amended by striking “2010” and inserting “2011”.

10 (b) PROTECTION AND ADVOCACY FOR BENEFICIARIES OF SOCIAL SECURITY.—Section 1150(h) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b–21(h)) is amended by striking “2010” and inserting “2011”.

14 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING CHANGES TO THE WORK INCENTIVES**  
15 **PLANNING AND ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

16 (a) ANNUAL REPORTS.—Section 1149 of the Social Security Act (as amended by section 2(a)) is further amended by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as subsections (d) and (e), respectively, and by inserting after subsection (b) the following new subsection:

21 “(c) ANNUAL REPORT.—Each entity awarded a  
22 grant, cooperative agreement, or contract under this section shall submit an annual report to the Commissioner  
23 on the benefits planning and assistance provided to individuals under such grant, agreement, or contract.”.

26 (b) ONE-YEAR CARRYOVER.—

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1149(b)(4) of such  
2 Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b–20(b)(4)) is amended—

3           (A) by striking “(4) ALLOCATION OF  
4 COSTS.—The costs” and inserting the following:  
5 “(4) FUNDING.—

6           “(A) ALLOCATION OF COSTS.—The costs”;  
7 and

8           (B) by adding at the end the following:

9           “(B) CARRYOVER.—An amount not in ex-  
10 cess of 10 percent of the total amount obligated  
11 through a grant, cooperative agreement, or con-  
12 tract awarded under this section for a fiscal  
13 year to a State or a private agency or organiza-  
14 tion shall remain available for obligation to  
15 such State or private agency or organization  
16 until the end of the succeeding fiscal year. Any  
17 such amount remaining available for obligation  
18 during such succeeding fiscal year shall be  
19 available for providing benefits planning and as-  
20 sistance only for individuals who are within the  
21 caseload of the recipient of the grant, agree-  
22 ment, or contract as of immediately before the  
23 beginning of such fiscal year.”.

24           (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
25 by paragraph (1) shall apply with respect to

1 amounts allotted under section 1149 of the Social  
2 Security Act for payment for a fiscal year after fis-  
3 cal year 2010.

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
