A BILL

To provide for general revenue sharing for States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "State and Local5 Spending Will Help Save America Act of 2010".

6 SEC. 2. GENERAL REVENUE SHARING.

7 (a) APPROPRIATION.—There is authorized to be appropriated and is appropriated to carry out this section
9 \$200,000,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2011 and 2012.
10 (b) PAYMENT.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall

11 pay to each State on a quarterly basis an amount equal12 to the amount allotted to the State under subsection (c).

(c) ALLOTMENTS.—From the amounts appropriated
 under subsection (a) for each fiscal year, the Secretary
 of the Treasury shall allot an amount to each of the States
 on the basis of the relative population of each such State,
 as determined by the Secretary of the Treasury on the
 basis of the most recent decennial census.

7 (d) USE OF FUNDS.—Funds received under this sec8 tion may be used only to supplement State operating
9 budgets and may not be used to supplement State capital
10 budgets.

11 (e) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Not later than 90 days after 12 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of 13 the Treasury shall make payments to States under this 14 section for fiscal year 2011. The Secretary of the Treasury 15 shall make payments to States under this section for fiscal 16 year 2012 not later than one year following the payments 17 for fiscal year 2011 under this section.

18 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.

19 In this Act:

20 (1) OPERATING BUDGET.—The term "operating
21 budget"—

(A) means the annual spending plan for
the recurring expenses of a State, including salaries, equipment, and repairs; and

(B) does not include expenses to build or 1 2 acquire permanent infrastructure. (2) STATE.—The term "State" means each of 3 the several States, the District of Columbia, the 4 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the United States 5 6 Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the 7 Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, and any other 8 territory or possession of the United States. 9
