To amend the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2008 to modify the threshold rates of unemployment that must be met by a State in order to establish eligibility for fourth-tier emergency unemployment compensation with respect to such State.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fairness in Unemploy-
5 ment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

2 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 4002(e)(2) of the Supple-
3 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (26 U.S.C. 3304 note)
4 is amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “6” and
6 inserting “4”; and

7 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking “8.5” and
8 inserting “7.0”.

9 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
10 subsection (a) shall apply to individuals exhausting third-
11 tier emergency unemployment compensation on or after
12 the date of the enactment of this Act.
