## AN ACT

To improve certain administrative operations of the Office of the Architect of the Capitol, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## SECTION 1. CONSOLIDATION OF STAFF POSITIONS.

- 2 (a) Consolidation.—Section 108 of the Legislative
- 3 Branch Appropriations Act, 1991 (2 U.S.C. 1849) is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 "Sec. 108. The Architect of the Capitol may fix the
- 6 rate of basic pay for not more than 32 positions at a rate
- 7 not to exceed the highest total rate of pay for the Senior
- 8 Executive Service under subchapter VIII of chapter 53 of
- 9 title 5, United States Code, for the locality involved.".
- 10 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 1203(e) of
- 11 the Legislative Branch Appropriations Act, 2003 (2)
- 12 U.S.C. 1805(e)) is amended by striking paragraph (3).
- (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 14 this section shall apply with respect to pay periods begin-
- 15 ning on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 16 SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS TO AC-
- 17 QUIRE BUILDING.
- 18 (a) AVAILABILITY.—The amounts described in sub-
- 19 section (b) shall be available to the Architect of the Capitol
- 20 for the acquisition (through purchase, lease, transfer from
- 21 another Federal entity, or otherwise) of real property for
- 22 the use of the Capitol Police.
- 23 (b) Amounts Described.—The amounts described
- 24 in this subsection are amounts appropriated to, and re-
- 25 maining available for obligation by, the Architect of the
- 26 Capitol under the heading "Architect of the Capitol, Cap-

- 1 itol Police Buildings and Grounds" or under the heading
- 2 "Architect of the Capitol, Capitol Police Buildings,
- 3 Grounds and Security" in any Act making appropriations
- 4 for the legislative branch for fiscal years 2007 through
- 5 2010.
