To suspend temporarily the duty on certain work boots for
men.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN WORK BOOTS FOR MEN.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.64.01	Work footwear for men with outer soles of rubber, plastics, leather or composition leather and uppers of leather, incorporating a protective toe cap of materials other than metal, covering the ankle to a height greater than 6" (provided for in subheading 6403.91.60.10)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2012	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
