## A BILL

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to extend the pilot program for alternative water source projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Healthy Communities  
5 Water Supply Act of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM FOR ALTERNATIVE WATER**  
7 **SOURCE PROJECTS.**

8 (a) SELECTION OF PROJECTS.—Section 220(d)(2) of  
9 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.  
10 1300(d)(2)) is amended by inserting before the period at

1 the end the following: “or whether the project is located  
2 in an area which is served by a public water system serving  
3 10,000 individuals or fewer”.

4 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
5 220(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33  
6 U.S.C. 1300(j)) is amended by striking “\$75,000,000 for  
7 fiscal years 2002 through 2004” and inserting  
8 “\$250,000,000”.
