To amend title IV of the Public Health Service Act to provide for the establishment of pediatric research consortia. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

# **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Pediatric Research
5 Consortia Establishment Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. NATIONAL PEDIATRIC RESEARCH CONSORTIA.

7 Subpart 7 of part C of title IV of the Public Health
8 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 285g et seq.) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

# 10 "SEC. 452H. NATIONAL PEDIATRIC RESEARCH CONSORTIA.

11 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Director of the National In-12 stitutes of Health, acting through the Director of the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development 13 and in collaboration with all other Institutes of the Na-14 15 tional Institutes of Health that support pediatric research, shall award grants, contracts, or cooperative agreements 16 to public or nonprofit private entities to pay all or part 17 18 of the cost of planning, establishing, and providing basic operating support for up to 20 national pediatric research 19 20 consortia.

21 "(b) RESEARCH.—Each consortium established
22 under subsection (a) shall supplement, but not replace, the
23 establishment of a comprehensive pediatric research port24 folio. Such consortium shall conduct basic, clinical, behav25 ioral, social, and translational research, as well as training

and demonstration of advanced diagnostic and treatment
 methods relating to pediatrics.

3 <u>"(c) COORDINATION OF CONSORTIA REPORTS.</u> The
4 Director of NIH shall—

5 <sup>((1)</sup> as appropriate, provide for the coordina-6 tion of information among consortia under sub-7 section (a) and ensure regular communication be-8 tween such consortia; and

9 <sup>((2)</sup> require the periodic preparation of reports 10 on the activities of the consortia and the submission 11 of the reports to the Director.

12 "(d) ORGANIZATION OF CONSORTIUM.— Each consor-13 tium established under subsection (a) shall be formed from 14 a collaboration of cooperating institutions with a lead in-15 stitution, meeting such requirements as may be prescribed 16 by the Director of NIH, including participation in a net-17 work of such consortium.

18 "(e) LIMITATION. Payments under subsection (a)
19 shall not exceed \$2,500,000 per year for each consortium
20 in the first 5 year cycle.

21 "(f) DURATION OF SUPPORT.—Support for a consor-22 tium established under subsection (a) may be provided 23 under this section for a period of 5 years and may be ex-24 tended for additional periods of 5 years each, with en-25 hanced funding opportunities based on a review of the operations by an appropriate scientific review group estab lished by the Director.".

# 10 "SEC. 452H. NATIONAL PEDIATRIC RESEARCH CONSORTIA.

11 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Director of NIH, acting 12 through the Director of the Eunice Kennedy Shriver National Institute of Child Health and Human Development 13 and in collaboration with all other Institutes of the Na-14 15 tional Institutes of Health that support pediatric research, may, subject to the availability of funds, award grants, con-16 tracts, or cooperative agreements to public or nonprofit pri-17 vate entities to pay all or part of the cost of planning, estab-18 lishing, and providing basic operating support for up to 19 20 national pediatric research consortia. The Director of 20 21 NIH shall take unmet research needs into account when 22 making awards under this section.

23 "(b) RESEARCH.—Research conducted under this sec24 tion shall supplement, but not replace, research that is oth25 erwise conducted or supported as part of the comprehensive

pediatric research portfolio of entities receiving awards
 under subsection (a). Consortia established under subsection
 (a) shall, in the aggregate, conduct basic, clinical, behav ioral, social, or translational research to meet unmet re search needs, as well as training in and demonstration of
 advanced diagnostic and treatment methods relating to pe diatrics, as appropriate.

8 "(c) COORDINATION OF CONSORTIA REPORTS.—The
9 Director of NIH shall—

"(1) as appropriate, provide for the coordination
of information among consortia established under
subsection (a) and ensure regular communication between such consortia; and

14 "(2) require the periodic preparation of reports
15 on the activities of the consortia and the submission
16 of the reports to the Director.

17 "(d) ORGANIZATION OF CONSORTIUM.—Each consor18 tium established under subsection (a) shall be formed from
19 a collaboration of cooperating institutions with a lead insti20 tution, meeting such requirements as may be prescribed by
21 the Director of NIH, including participation in a network
22 of such consortia.

23 "(e) LIMITATION.—Payments under subsection (a)
24 shall not exceed \$2,500,000 per year for each consortium
25 in the first 5-year cycle.

"(f) DURATION OF PAYMENTS.—Payments under sub section (a) for a consortium may be provided under this
 section for a period of 5 years and may be extended for
 additional periods of 5 years each, with enhanced funding
 opportunities based on a review of the operations by an ap propriate scientific review.".
