To validate final patent number 27–2005–0081, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINAL PATENT AND LAND RECONFIGURATION**

4 **IN CLARK COUNTY AND LINCOLN COUNTY,**

5 **NEVADA.**

6 Patent No. 27–2005–0081 and its associated land re-
7 configuration issued by the Bureau of Land Management
8 on February 18, 2005, is hereby affirmed and validated
9 as having been issued pursuant to and in compliance with
10 the provisions of the Nevada-Florida Land Exchange Au-
11 thorization Act of 1988 (Public Law 100–275), the Na-

1 tional Environmental Policy Act of 1969, and the Federal
2 Land Policy Management Act of 1976 for the benefit of
3 the desert tortoise and other species and their habitat to
4 increase the likelihood of their recovery. The process uti-
5 lized by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and
6 the Bureau of Land Management in reconfiguring the
7 lands as shown on Exhibit 1–4 of the Final Environmental
8 Impact Statement for the Planned Development Project
9 MSHCP, Lincoln County, NV (FWS–R8–ES–2008–
10 N0136) and the reconfiguration provided for in Special
11 Condition 10 of Army Corps of Engineers Permit No.
12 200125042 are hereby ratified.
