RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2314) to express the policy of the United States regarding the United States relationship with Native Hawaiians and to provide a process for the recognition by the United States of the Native Hawaiian governing entity.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 2314) to express the policy of the United States regarding
- 4 the United States relationship with Native Hawaiians and

1 to provide a process for the recognition by the United
2 States of the Native Hawaiian governing entity. All points
3 of order against consideration of the bill are waived except
4 those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The bill
5 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
6 provisions of the bill are waived. The previous question
7 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any
8 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
9 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
10 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
11 the Committee on Natural Resources; (2) the amendment
12 in the nature of a substitute printed in part A of the re-
13 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolu-
14 tion, if offered by Representative Abercrombie of Hawaii
15 or his designee, which shall be in order without interven-
16 tion of any point of order except those arising under clause
17 9 or 10 of rule XXI, shall be considered as read, and shall
18 be separately debatable for 30 minutes equally divided and
19 controlled by the proponent and an opponent; (3) the
20 amendments to the amendment in the nature of a sub-
21 stitute printed in part B of the report of the Committee
22 on Rules, each of which may be offered only by a Member
23 designed in the report, shall be in order without interven-
24 tion of any point of order except those arising under clause
25 10 of rule XXI, shall be considered as read, and shall be

1 separately debatable for 10 minutes equally divided and
2 controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (4) one
3 motion to recommit with or without instructions.

4 SEC. 2. During consideration of an amendment print-
5 ed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules ac-
6 companying this resolution, the Chair may postpone the
7 question of adoption as though under clause 8 of rule XX.
