Mr. POLIS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2499) to provide for a federally sanctioned self-determination process for the people of Puerto Rico.

Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider ation of the bill (H.R. 2499) to provide for a federally
sanctioned self-determination process for the people of
Puerto Rico. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-

pensed with. All points of order against consideration of 1 the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 2 3 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be confined to the 4 bill and shall not exceed one hour and 30 minutes, with 5 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and 6 ranking minority member of the Committee on Natural 7 Resources and 30 minutes controlled by Representative 8 Velazquez of New York or her designee. After general de-9 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the 10 five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-11 12 minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute 13 recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the 14 15 nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points of order against the committee amendment in the 16 17 nature of a substitute are waived except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 18 19 of rule XVIII, no amendment to the committee amend-20 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except 21 those printed in the report of the Committee on Rules ac-22 companying this resolution. Each such amendment may 23 be offered only in the order printed in the report, may 24 be offered only by a Member designated in the report, 25 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time

specified in the report equally divided and controlled by 1 2 the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to 3 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-4 sion of the question. All points of order against such 5 amendments are waived except those arising under clause 6 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration 7 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and 8 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may 9 have been adopted. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to 10 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-11 12 tion to recommit with or without instructions.

13 SEC. 2. The Chair may entertain a motion that the 14 Committee rise only if offered by the chair of the Com-15 mittee on Natural Resources or his designee. The Chair 16 may not entertain a motion to strike out the enacting 17 words of the bill (as described in clause 9 of rule XVIII).
